IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The **State of Ohio** requires children to be immunized if they are enrolled in public or private school for kindergarten,

Please Submit Shot Records at Registration

KINDERGARTNERS NEED:

- 1. HEP B (Hepatitis B)
 - 3 doses required may take 6 months to complete
- 2. MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
 - 2 doses required, the first dose given on or after the first birthday.
- **3. DTaP/DT Tdap/Td** (Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus)
 - **5 doses required** If the 4th dose was given at least 6 months after the 3rd dose, and on or after the 4th birthday, a 5th dose is not required.
- **4. <u>IPV</u>** (Polio)
 - 3 or more doses required: last dose to be given on or after 4th birthday.
- 5. VARICELLA (Chickenpox) or disease history
 - **2 doses required,** the 1st dose being given on or after the first birthday. If the student has had the disease, verification/date may be provided by physician or parent.
