Contact your medical provider for any medical concerns and medical advice. In the event of a life-threatening medical emergency, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency department.

### Will we receive classroom / building letters or notifications?

At this time, districts are no longer required to contact trace or provide notification.

#### What if a household member tests positive?

You may continue to attend school or work with no symptoms. You will need to continue to monitor yourself for symptom development and wearing a mask is recommended.

#### Is a negative COVID test required to return to school or work?

A negative COVID test is not required at this time.

#### Are we required to wear masks?

Those who wish to wear a mask may do so but WCSD is not requiring masks at this time.
