On-line Registration Only:

REGISTER ON-LINE: This is a two-part registration.

Part 1: Register for class. Go to WCSOH.ORG; at the bottom of the page under "Resources" click on Summer School; at the right of page under "Documents" click on High School Summer Registration.

Part 2: You must pay by mailing a check or Pay via EZPay (in-district students only). The EZPay link can be found by going to WCSOH.ORG; at the bottom of the page under "Resources" click on EZPay. There is a \$2.75 non-refundable processing fee using EZPay.

REFUND POLICY:

All refunds will be subject to a processing fee.

All cancelations must be received in writing/email to: hoffmanrh@wcsoh.org

If a student registers/pays for a summer class; later finds out (s)he passed the class during the school year and does not need to take the summer class, a full refund will be given.

Cancel 2 or more weeks prior to first day of class – Possible \$20 fee per class.

Cancel less than 2 weeks prior to first day of class – Possible \$30 fee per class.

Cancel less than 1 week prior to first day of class – Possible \$40 fee per class.

After 1st class begins -- \$100 fee per 1-credit class // \$50 fee per .5 credit class (Advancement Class)

After 1st class begins -- \$25 fee per 1-credit class // \$10 fee per .5 credit class (Recovery Class)

After 1st complete week of class -- No Refund.

Residents that live in district, but attend a private school or are home schooled, must show proof of residency for WCS in-district cost. Proof of residency includes:

Purchase contract agreement to buy/lease property (closing date to be within 90 days of enrollment); OR up-to-date rental/lease agreement or mortgage statement with custodial parent's name and all adult residents listed; Current copy of one of the following: electric, water, gas, landline phone, cable, internet bill, or Government mailing (i.e. child support, government assistance). This must be included with your registration and verified before being processed.

Important Updated Information Below due to Covid-19 Closures

Instructional Delivery

This summer, students will attend virtually from home. Course instructors will be available throughout the week using email, the Remind App, and most importantly Schoology/Google Hangout Meet sessions. Participating students in all courses will receive a Schoology/Google Hangout Meeting link invitation prior to the course starting with three dates/times to choose from to attend an initial orientation session on best practices in using the Apex platform, engaging the instructor, and completing coursework online. Throughout the duration of the course, instructors will host frequent opportunities using virtual sessions for students to interact, better understand course material, and ask questions.

Attendance and Course Completion

We have found students that engage in course curriculum on a daily basis for **a minimum of 3 hours a day**, will have the most success of course completion in the time frame given in summer school. It should take a student no more than three weeks to complete a .50 credit course and six weeks to complete a 1 credit course.

Course Selection

Students are permitted to register for up to 1 credit during summer school. If a student finishes a course within a reasonable amount of summer school time left, they can register and pay for another course providing the Teacher and/or Summer Principal feel the student will have success in completion of another course.

***Credit Recovery for WCS Students Only**

Available for current Westerville City School students only. Students must have already received a final grade for the course and recorded on their PowerSchool historical grades. This will be verified. Students that have never taken the course will take the course for Credit Advancement. **This year only, pending Board approval, credit recovery course fees have been reduced due to support families due to the impact of school closures this Spring. Course advancement fees will remain the same as in previous years.**

Letter Grade

Students will receive a letter grade and percentage for each course taken. If a student is taking for a credit recovery course, this summer school grade will replace the grade given on previous transcript. Please be aware that both grades will show on the transcript, but the better grade received will be used in calculating student GPA. The credit recovery course taken must be the same of course failed in order for it to be a grade replacement.

Physical Education Course Offerings

For this course, there will be academic work to be done online as well as documented physical activity required by the student at home.

Students can complete PE1 and PE2 at their own pace and can complete both courses well within the timeframe of the summer school dates.

****Ohio's State Tests (OST) – TO BE DETERMINED DUE TO COVID-19**

Students in these identified courses are required to take end-of-course assessments as one pathway in order to graduate. The Ohio Department of Education (ODE) establishes the test administration schedule. Students taking these identified courses are encouraged to take the corresponding State end-of-course exam on July 13 and/or July 14, 7:45am in the media center at Westerville Central HS (WCHS) as opposed to waiting to take the assessment during the next test administration window of late fall/winter 2020. Students that have previously taken an end-of-course exam and scored a 1 or 2 may re-take the assessment on either July 13 or 14 beginning at 7:45am in the WCHS media center.
