## Panorama Student Survey

Dear Westerville City School District Families,

As a school system, we are always seeking ways to improve the various services that we make available to our students and families. One of our primary efforts of late has been to learn how we can best support students on not just their academic needs, but also on a social-emotional level.

In order to learn more about student experiences in Westerville City Schools, we will be seeking students' opinions via an online needs assessment/survey that they will complete in the coming weeks. Hybrid students will survey at school while WVA students will survey remotely. We expect the survey to take approximately ten to fifteen minutes to complete.

## Quarter 4 Grades

Quarter 4 ends on Wednesday, May 26. Students must have all assignments, quizzes, and tests completed and submitted by this date. The Quarter 4 grade will be based on the Grade to Date. The Grade to Date is determined by dividing the total points earned by the student, in the course, by the total points possible for the course. (Example: A student earns 750 points in the course. There are 1,000 points possible for the course.  $750 \div 1000 = 75\% = C$ ).

## Final Grade Calculation

The last day of classes is Wednesday, May 26. The final grade for the course is equal to the Quarter 4 grade (Grade to Date). The final grade is determined the same way, by dividing the total points earned by the student, in the course, by the total points possible for the course. (Example: A student earns 850 points in the course. There are 1,000 points possible for the course.  $850 \div 1000 = 85\% = B$ ).

## Semester 1 Incompletes

For students who received an incomplete "I" in a core academic course at the end of the 2nd grading period:

- ♦ All incomplete work in core academic courses from grading period 2 is **due no later than Friday, May 14**.
- ♦ Incomplete work not submitted by May 14 will be recorded as a zero when the grading period 2 incomplete "I" is converted to a grade.
