## Free Health Insurance for your Child

Children (up to age 19) and pregnant women can get free health coverage through Healthy Start. Healthy Start covers the following services:

Families can apply for Healthy Start by filling out the Combined Programs Application (CPA) - JFS Form #07216. By calling the Consumer Hotline at 1-800-324-8680, hotline staff can provide general information or offer assistance in filling out the application. Families can find applications at their local office of job & family services. Also, Nationwide Children's Hospital counselors are available to help with paperwork at no cost.
