

One-Word Speech

For your first assignment in Speech 1, you will be doing a one-minute presentation based on a single word. This word is not supposed to be just any word, but a word that embodies who you are. It should be a word that you connect with, in one way or another. This word can be something that describes you, it can be a word that explains how you live your life, a word that has special meaning to you, etc. In your presentation, you will explain the connection that you have with this particular word. So, if you choose "happy," you give a one-minute presentation that addresses how you connect with the word "happy." The catch is that you cannot have the same word as somebody else. Words will be chosen strictly on a first-come, first-served basis. If you are having trouble thinking of a word, or the word you wanted to use was already selected by someone else, ask for help or use a thesaurus to find another applicable word. Be sure to choose a word that you know, and do not just wing it.

Requirements:

- One minute in length
