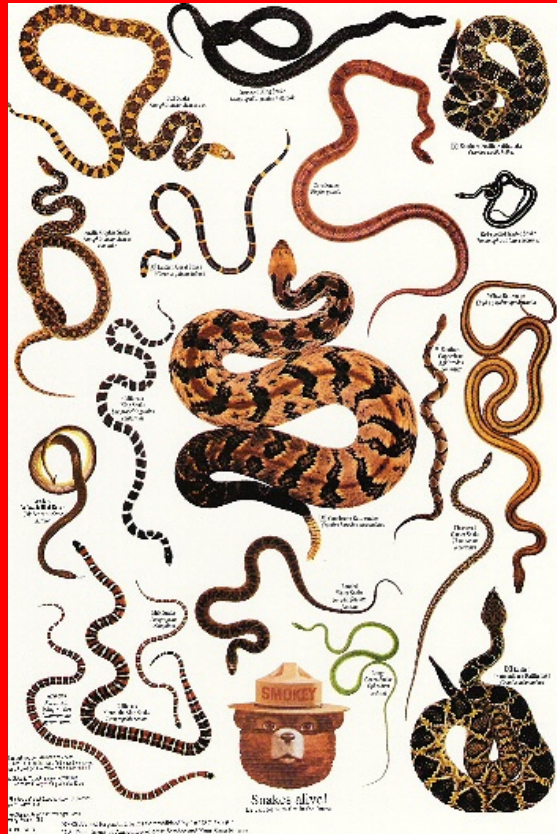

Physical description of a snake



Snakes lay 10-100 eggs a time. Snakes have poor eye sight so they use smell and feel to get around. Snakes are covered in scales and slither around the ground and in the trees. There are 2,700 different species only a 5th is venomous to humans. They have two holes on each side of its head to breathe their mouth is used for navigational purpose.

Family of a snake



Some snakes don't live with family they only are with other snakes if they're matting or just hatched. Pythons are mostly the ones that are kept for pets because they are not venoms and the easiest to take care of. The babies when they hatch they blend in better with its surroundings.

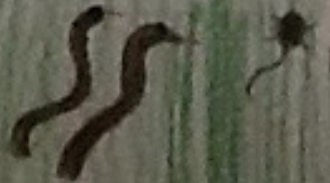
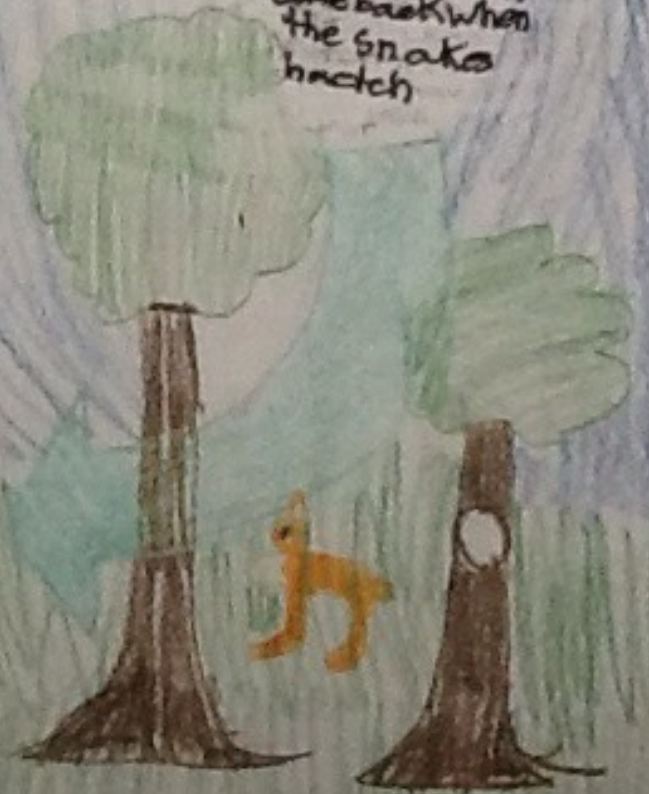

first fact

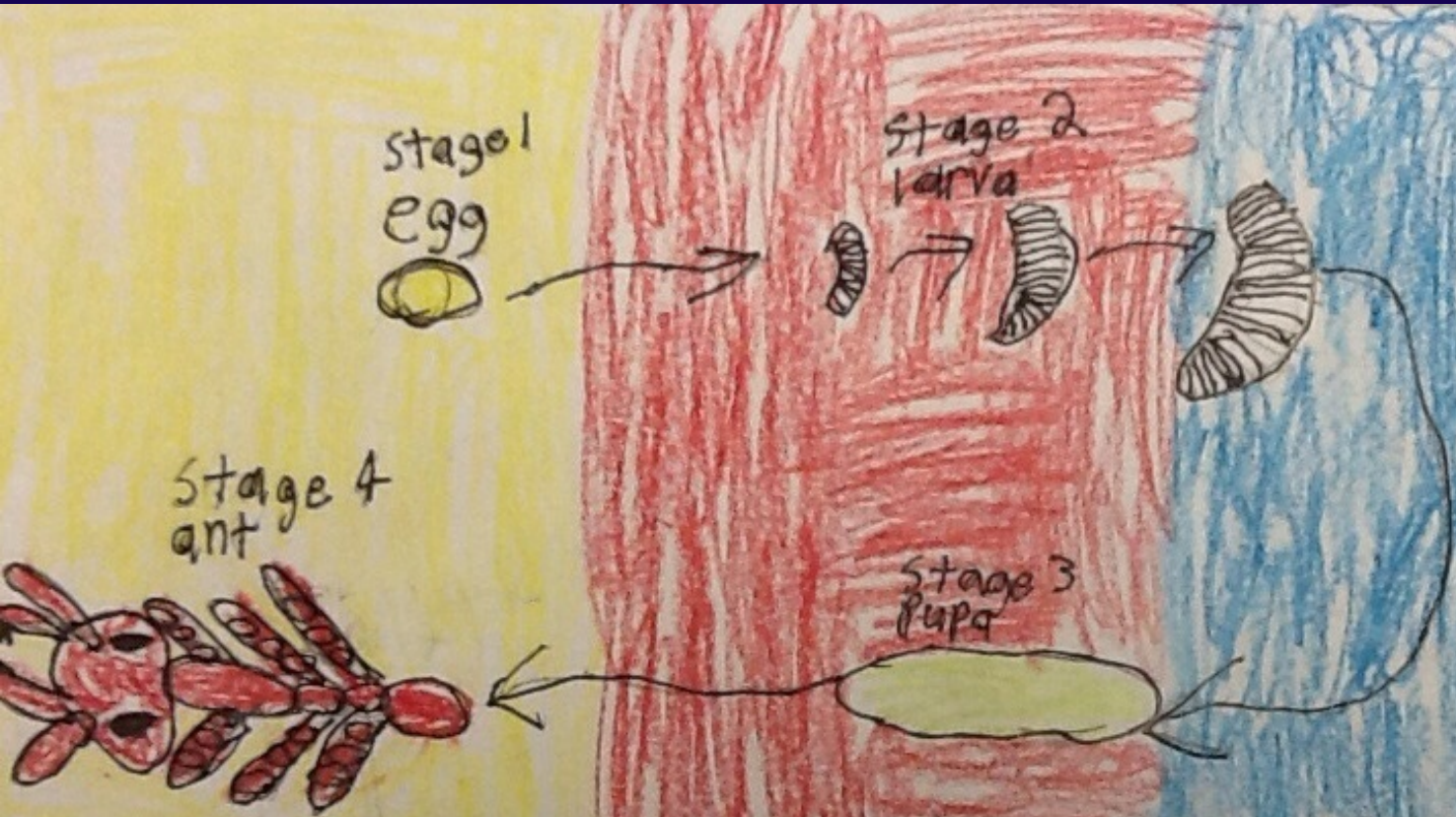
The ants move the larva and the eggs to the bottom of the nest at night to keep them warm and in the morning they move the eggs and larva to the bottom of the nest.

third fact

The leaf cutter ants are farmers they cut out pieces of leaves which they take back to their nest they chew them into pulp and a special fungus grows on it then they eat the fungus off of the leaf.
