

School Lunch & Breakfast for 2022/2023

Pointers, Tips and Info!

1. School lunch and breakfast are back to “normal” and are NOT free for everyone this school year.
 - To see if your family qualifies for free or reduced price food at school, you must fill out an application every year!
 - Go to <https://www.lunchapplication.com>
 - On the application you will agree to the terms and conditions, select OH for Ohio and then choose Westerville City Schools.
 - Eligibility will be determined after you complete the application.

2. EZpay is the website where you can add money to your students lunch account. Please make sure to do this and set up alerts for low balances. You will need to set up an account the first time you log into the site.
